Adapting A Vocal Melody To The Bass

- 1. Always start with the vocals & lyrics.
- 2. Capture the vocals melodic phrasing.
- 3. Look at each word & syllable. How are these sung?
- 4. Perform with the vocals in mind.
- 5. Don't mask the melody with fills, ornamentation and riffs. This takes away from the most important element.....The melody.
- 6. Look at the rhythmical phrasing when playing highly syncopated melodies.
- 7. Learn the melody by heart and use the lyrics as an overall guide. Have the lyric sheet on your music stand.
- 8. The bass is a great, under rated instrument on which to play melodies. The instrument range is close to the human voice. Especially the 6 string or extended range bass.
